BACKGROUND

There are a number of providers who offer seminars on weather decision making a weather for specific activities. The list below is not exhaustive so if you find something else, please let us know so we can share with other pilots and confirm its suitability as an EDUCATION module.

PROVIDERS

GASCO offer **Weather Decision Making for GA**, a day long course based at the Met Office in Exeter. This covers the basics of weather decision making and is hosted by the Met experts themselves and is suitable for Microlight pilots as well as Group A pilots

GASCo/RMetS offer **Virtual Weather - Venturing across the Channel**, a half day webinar covering the additional weather challenges that flying in Europe can present.

GASCo/RMetS offer **Virtual Weather - Weather for General Aviation Licence holders**, a half day webinar covering similar content to the Weather Decision making course.
