HOW TO BOOK

Both part 1 and part 2 weather school course run over two mornings and are delivered online (at present) with a total of 6 hours live teaching time with Dr Simon Keeling. Either course meets the Wings requirements (but you need pt1 before you can book on pt 2)

COSTS

OBJECTIVE

The aim of this course is to help pilots maximise flying opportunities through an understanding of weather trends, weather fronts, airmasses and winds and using all these pieces of information to assess the hazards for the flight planning.

BACKGROUND

This course will look at how to maximise your flying time, accurately plan the flying weather the next 5-days, and get the aircraft booked before anyone else.

Understanding the weather is a huge boost to pilot safety. Learn how to avoid being caught by cloud, sabotaged by snow, messed about by mist ... you get the picture!

SYLLABUS

Topics covered included airmasses, the atmosphere, frontal systems, pressure systems, cloud development & forecasting, weather data as well as a Q & A session.

You will use today's charts to investigate how our flying would have been affected today.

You will also get a good old guided tour through the 214/215 charts and learn to watch the weather developing. The mystery of TAFs and METARs will be revealed
