### **POINTS**

# OBJECTIVE

To provide safety awareness through theory & instructor led skills development for safer high terrain flying

#### **BACKGROUND**

A number of special skills are required to safely fly close to steep or high terrain. Developed as a first step towards a practical mountain flying course, this seminar will provide a good level of advice for those likely to pass over or through high terrain.

## **HOW TO BOOK**

This course can be delivered by BMAA flying schools.

The **ground school** element can be offered by pilots with recognized experience of flying within high terrain and verified with BMAA HQ.

The **flight skill** element must be led by an instructor.

# COSTS

Costs will depend on provider. This makes an excellent seminar for clubs & flying schools

If completed without the flight practice element, this course can be used as an EDUCATION

#### **SYLLABUS**

This course is designed to be delivered by an experienced instructor in around 3 hours plus flights as appropriate to the individual pilot's experience.

This seminar is split into 4 main topics:

- 1. High Terrain/Mountain weather
- 2. Technical considerations
- 3. Human Factors
- 4. Enroute considerations

Three short videos are included to illustrate examples of flying around high terrain.

There is an outline of suitable flight skills for the pilot to complete with an instructor. There is no set number of hours to completion but both pilot and instructor should be happy with the standard of skills displayed as demonstration of an understanding of the hazards and issues of operating around terrain.

## **COMPLETION**
