# **OBJECTIVE**

## BACKGROUND

GASCo have been running safety evenings both in person and online for a number of years. This module is the popular 'safety evening' where visiting speakers join the team of GASCo Regional Safety Officers and a short Q&A session is included.

GASCo was founded in 1964 to provide a forum in which all of the General Aviation organisations could meet to share safety information. Today almost every organisation that represents those who supply, maintain, control, support, regulate and, most importantly, fly each and every kind of flying machine is a member of GASCo. They meet to share experiences and ideas for the improvement of flight safety.

In addition to the Council Meetings for the member organisations, GASCo produces GASCo Flight Safety magazine (for a small subscription), the free monthly enewsletter Flight Safety Extra, organises Safety Evenings, seminars and flight safety events.
