### BMAA

### BACKGROUND

Commercial operations have been teaching Crew Resource Management for decades. This course has been written to allow the very best of these principles to be applied to the Microlight world where we're usually working in a 'single pilot' scenario. The focus is on learning from others' experience and developing good practice.

This course has been prepared for the BMAA by two microlight pilots who have extensive experience in the commercial & military aviation environments.

### SYLLABUS

The Single Pilot Resource Management (SRM) course consists of 6 sections and a summary. It can be studied online or in a flight school or club setting.
